



Website Terms of Use

Trinity Methodist Church Jacksonville NC Effective September 1, 2026

These Terms of Use govern your access to and use of trinityjaxnc.church and the online services that link to these terms. Please read them before using the website. By accessing or using the website, you agree to these terms. If you do not agree, please do not use the website.

1 About This Website

This website is operated by Trinity Methodist Church in Jacksonville, North Carolina. It provides information about worship, ministries, preschool, events, forms, giving, sermons, and other church activities. References to “Trinity,” “the church,” “we,” “us,” or “our” mean Trinity Methodist Church.

2 Appropriate Use

You may use the website for lawful, personal, and noncommercial purposes related to learning about or participating in Trinity’s ministries and activities. You agree to provide accurate information when submitting a form, registering for an event, making a payment, or contacting the church.

You may not:

- use the website to violate any law or another person’s rights;
- submit false, fraudulent, threatening, abusive, obscene, or harmful material;
- attempt to gain unauthorized access to the website, an account, a form, or connected systems;
- introduce malware, interfere with website operation, or bypass security measures;
- collect personal information about other users without permission; or
- copy, scrape, reproduce, or use website content for commercial purposes without written permission.

3 Church Content and Intellectual Property

Unless otherwise stated, the website’s text, graphics, photographs, videos, sermons, recordings, logos, designs, and other content belong to Trinity Methodist Church or are used with permission. You may view and share links to public pages for personal, ministry, or informational purposes. You may not reproduce, modify, sell, license, republish, or distribute substantial portions of the content without prior written permission, except as allowed by law.

Names, logos, and branding displayed on the website may be trademarks or service marks of Trinity or other organizations. Use of the website does not grant you ownership or a license to use those marks.



4 Donations Payments and Purchases

Donations, tuition, registration fees, event fees, purchases, and other payments may be processed through third-party payment providers. You agree to provide current and accurate payment information and authorize the applicable charge. The payment provider's terms and privacy policy also apply to the transaction.

A donation is a voluntary gift and does not purchase goods or services unless a page clearly states otherwise. Donations are generally final. A receipt does not guarantee that a payment is tax deductible; please consult a qualified tax adviser about your circumstances.

5 Refunds Cancellations and Program Terms

Refund, cancellation, attendance, eligibility, and transfer rules may differ by program or transaction. The terms shown on the applicable registration, payment, event, preschool, or product page control. Trinity Preschool registration fees are nonrefundable as stated on the preschool page. If no specific rule is displayed, contact the church office before paying if you have questions.

Trinity may change or cancel a service, event, class, ministry activity, or program because of weather, safety concerns, staffing, facility needs, low participation, or other circumstances. When appropriate, the church will communicate available alternatives or any refund decision.

6 Registrations Forms and Accounts

Some services may require a registration, online form, or account with Trinity or a third-party provider such as Planning Center, Wix, ClassDojo, or a payment processor. You are responsible for information submitted through your account and for protecting your login credentials. Notify the provider and Trinity promptly if you believe an account connected with church activities has been misused.

Submitting a form does not guarantee admission, enrollment, facility use, volunteer placement, event space, pastoral assistance, or another requested outcome. Acceptance may depend on available space, payment, required documents, safety requirements, eligibility, or approval by church leadership.

7 Children and Youth

A parent or legal guardian should complete online registrations and forms for a child under 18 unless Trinity provides a different approved process. Participation in preschool, children's ministry, youth activities, or another supervised program may require separate permissions, releases, medical information, pickup authorization, conduct expectations, or safety procedures. Those program-specific requirements are in addition to these terms.



8 Information You Submit

You retain ownership of original information or material you submit. You give Trinity permission to use it as reasonably necessary to respond to your request, administer a ministry or program, protect participants, keep appropriate records, and operate the website. Prayer requests and pastoral communications will be handled with care, but ordinary website forms and email should not be treated as guaranteed confidential or emergency communication channels.

Do not submit content that you do not have the right to share. Photographs, testimonials, recordings, or stories will be used publicly only when Trinity has an appropriate basis or permission to do so.

9 Third Party Services and Links

The website may use or link to services operated by other organizations, including Wix, Stripe, Planning Center, ClassDojo, YouTube, livestream providers, maps, calendars, social-media platforms, and other ministry or technology services. Trinity does not control those services and is not responsible for their availability, content, security, or practices. Your use of them is governed by their own terms and privacy policies.

10 Website Information

We try to keep website information accurate and current, but schedules, prices, availability, staff information, ministry details, links, and other content may change. Website content is provided for general information and is not professional legal, medical, financial, counseling, or emergency advice. Confirm time-sensitive information with the church office or the ministry contact listed on the relevant page.

11 Availability and Changes

Trinity may change, suspend, restrict, or discontinue any part of the website at any time. We do not promise that the website will always be available, uninterrupted, error-free, secure, or compatible with every device. We may correct errors and update content without notice.

12 Disclaimer of Warranties

To the fullest extent permitted by law, the website and its content are provided “as is” and “as available,” without warranties of any kind, whether express or implied. This includes implied warranties of accuracy, merchantability, fitness for a particular purpose, title, and noninfringement. Some laws may not allow certain exclusions, so portions of this section may not apply to you.

13 Limitation of Liability

To the fullest extent permitted by law, Trinity Methodist Church and its clergy, staff, leaders, volunteers, and service providers will not be liable for indirect, incidental, special, consequential, or punitive damages arising from use of, or inability to use, the website or a linked service. Nothing in these terms excludes liability that cannot lawfully be excluded.



14 Privacy

Use of personal information collected through the website is described in Trinity's Website Privacy Policy. That policy is incorporated into these terms by reference.

15 Governing Law

These terms are governed by the laws of the State of North Carolina, without regard to conflict-of-law principles. Any legal proceeding relating to these terms or the website must be brought in a court with proper jurisdiction in Onslow County, North Carolina, unless applicable law requires otherwise.

16 Severability and No Waiver

If any part of these terms is found unenforceable, the remaining terms will continue in effect. A delay or failure by Trinity to enforce a provision does not waive the right to enforce it later.

17 Changes to These Terms

We may update these terms as the website, ministries, services, or legal requirements change. The effective date at the top shows when the terms were last revised. Continued use of the website after updated terms are posted means you accept the revised terms.
